The Inauguration of 2021 ASEAN-China Year of Sustainable Development Cooperation Held in Beijing

On May 28, the Inauguration of 2021 ASEAN-China Year of Sustainable Development Cooperation was held in Beijing. Zhao Yingmin, Vice Minister of Ecology and Environment of the People's Republic of China; Haji Suhaimi bin Haji Gafar, Minister of Development of Brunei Darussalam, rotating chair of the ASEAN; Lim Jock Hoi, Secretary-General of Association of Southeast Asian Nations; and representatives from the Embassy of the Republic of Philippines to the People's Republic of China and the Royal Thai Embassy to the People's Republic of China attended and addressed the ceremony.

It is stressed that China attaches great importance to the strategic partnership with ASEAN. Since the establishment of ASEAN-China Dialogue Relations 30 years ago, the two sides have been engaged in friendly exchange and cooperation in eco-environment protection, disaster prevention and reduction, climate change response, poverty alleviation, and other areas concerning sustainable development. Under the guidance of Xi Jinping Thought on Ecological Civilization, the Chinese government has been actively implementing the new development philosophy and pursuing a new path of green and low-carbon development which gives priority to ecological conservation. So far, positive progress has been made with significant ecological and environmental improvements, which helps to consolidate the foundation for ASEAN-China sustainable development cooperation.

It is pointed out on the meeting that China is willing to work together with ASEAN to implement the *Framework ASEAN-China Environmental Cooperation Strategy and Action Plan (2021-2025)* and promote cooperation in biodiversity conservation, climate change response, air quality improvement, sustainable cities, marine plastics reduction and other issues of common concern through policy dialogue, capacity building and pilot programs. China will continue to implement "China-ASEAN Green Envoys Program", share policies, models and measures on ecological civilization construction and green development and make joint efforts to promote capacity building of environmental governance and raise public awareness on environment protection in the region.

In their remarks, representatives expressed the expectation that the two sides could regard the event as a new milestone to further explore pathways for sustainable development and enhance sustainable development cooperation.
